

Welcome to Bellevue Memorial Park – a 78 acre. beautifully manicured, private, non-profit, nondenominational historic cemetery established in 1892 to serve the community. In 2017 Bellevue received the coveted George Chaffey Memorial Award from the City of Ontario for leadership preserving Ontario's cultural heritage. The cemetery includes two magnificent mausoleum structures, over 41 grass-covered ground

sections and over 600 spectacular trees, all set within 15 specially named private roads. More than 62,500 people (including thousands of historic grave sites in the East End) are currently interred at Bellevue with many decades of space available in the future for all families. The Bellevue Memorial Park office and ground staff are here to assist with any questions you may have.

To preserve the beauty and safety of Bellevue Memorial Park, please observe the following policies:

- Each interment site is provided with one flower vase per interment when purchased. Replacement vases are available at cemetery office if original vase is unusable or missing
- It is the family's responsibility to maintain their flower vase for all ground burial, crypt and niche spaces.

The following decorations are not permitted at any time and will be removed immediately:

- Fences or borders of any kind around interment sites
- Planter boxes, stones, glass/ceramic items, ornaments, statues and solar lights
- Anything attached to cemetery trees and/or shrubs
- No decorations should encroach on interment sites owned by others

For safety and courtesy, the following activities are not permitted at any time:

- Personal tents, canopies, food, music or drinks
- No alcohol on cemetery grounds at anytime
- Balls, bats and other sports equipment are prohibited
