## Flower and Decoration Policy

To preserve the beauty of Bellevue Memorial Park for all families and visitors, please observe the following rules:

- Each interment site (ground, crypt or niche) is provided with one flower vase. Each family is responsible to maintain their flower vase. Replacement vases are available at cemetery office if original vase is unusable or missing.

- ALL FLOWERS AND DECORATIONS WILL BE REMOVED ON THE "MOWING DAY" SHOWN BELOW. ALSO, SEE MOWING SCHEDULE SIGN AT CEMETERY ENTRANCE AND COLOR CODED CURBS AROUND EACH SECTION.** Full maps also available in cemetery office.

- Flowers and decorations should be removed only by the owner of the property and/or the cemetery staff.

The following decorations are **not permitted** at any time and will be removed immediately:

- Anything attached to cemetery trees, shrubs and/or walls
- Trenching around grave or markers
- Fences or borders of any kind around interment sites
- Planter boxes, stones, glass/ceramic items, ornaments, statues and solar lights
- No decorations should encroach on interment sites owned by others
- Alcoholic beverages / containers

For safety and courtesy, the following items and activities are **not permitted at any time**:

- Personal tents, canopies, food, music, drinks or barbecuing
- No alcohol on cemetery grounds at anytime
- Balls, bats and other sports equipment are prohibited

Decorative (artificial) Christmas trees are allowed only during the holiday schedule in December and are subject to the holiday schedule removal policy. Trees must not exceed **4ft in height**.

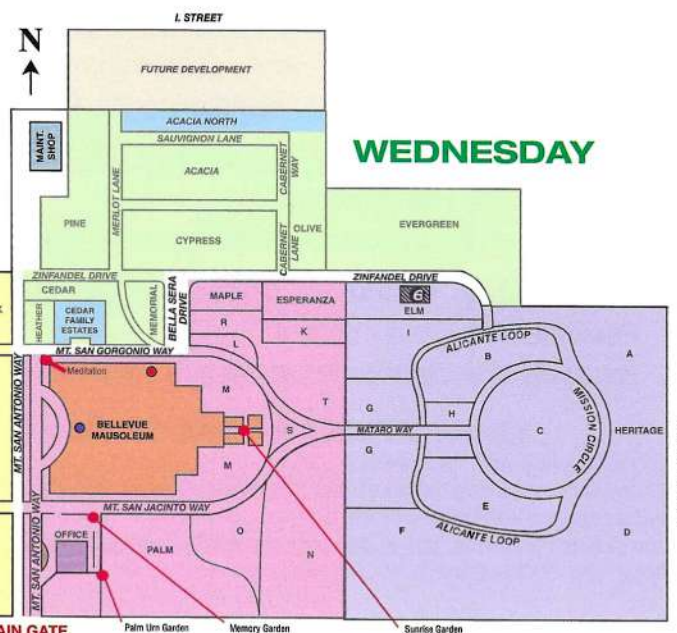
**Mausoleum Buildings Daily Visiting Hours:**

During the dates below, no lawns will be mowed. During warm weather (regardless of season) the grass will grow very quickly and it will be very long.

### **Valentine's Day, Friday, February 14, 2025**

Placement by Family begins

Saturday, February 8, 2025

Removal of decorations by cemetery crew. Regular mowing schedule restarts

Monday, February 17, 2025

### **Easter, Sunday, April 20, 2025**

Placement by Family begins

Saturday, April 19, 2025

Removal of decorations by cemetery crew. Regular mowing schedule restarts

Monday, April 28, 2025

### **Mother's Day, Sunday, May 11, 2025**

Placement by Family begins

Saturday, May 10, 2025

Removal of decorations by cemetery crew. Regular mowing schedule restarts

Monday, May 19, 2025

### **Memorial Day, Monday, May 26, 2025 – Annual Celebration Program at Bellevue.**

Placement by Family begins

Saturday, May 24, 2025

Removal of decorations by cemetery crew. Regular mowing schedule restarts

Monday, June 2, 2025

### **Flag Day, Saturday, June 14, 2025 – Placement of American flags allowed.**

**Important** – Cemetery personnel not involved in placement/pick up of American Flags on this day. Families are responsible for placement and removal before next mowing day in each section.

### **Father's Day, Sunday, June 15, 2025**

Placement by Family begins

Saturday, June 14, 2025

Removal of decorations by cemetery crew. Regular mowing schedule restarts

Monday, June 23, 2025

### **Halloween, Friday, October 31, 2025 / All Souls, Sunday, November 2, 2025**

Placement by Family begins

Saturday, October 25, 2025

Removal of decorations by cemetery crew. Regular mowing schedule restarts

Monday, November 3, 2025

### **Veterans Day, Tuesday, November 11, 2025 – Placement of American flags allowed.**

Placement of flags by cemetery personnel in Veteran and Memorial Lawn only.

Saturday, November 8, 2025

Removal of decorations by cemetery crew. Regular mowing schedule restarts

Monday, November 17, 2025

### **Thanksgiving, Thursday, November 27, 2025**

Placement by Family begins

Saturday, November 22, 2025

Removal of decorations by cemetery crew. Regular mowing schedule restarts

Monday, December 1, 2025

### **Christmas Day, Thursday, December 25, 2025**

Placement by Family begins

Saturday, December 13, 2025

Removal of decorations by cemetery crew. Regular mowing schedule restarts

Monday, January 5, 2026

### **General Policy for Special Placement and Removal of Flowers/Decorations.**

Special Flowers and decorations should not be placed until the dates indicated above, otherwise they will be disposed of during weekly maintenance. Removal of floral and decorations by cemetery personnel will begin early morning on the cemetery removal date listed above. Please retrieve your decorations prior to posted date above or they will be discarded during maintenance activities. Pay careful attention to dates posted because "going through cemetery trash containers for any reason is NOT ALLOWED AT ANYTIME." Be aware replacement of flowers and decorations is not allowed until after 3:00pm on your mowing day.

Please remember that the placement by families of flowers and decorations at any location inside cemetery grounds is done at the family's risk. Bellevue Memorial Park is not responsible for lost, stolen, discarded or disturbed items under any circumstances.
